## **Introduction**

Welcome to your Past Life report. Whereas the birthchart is a symbolic road map describing your current life, the Past Lives chart is a blueprint of your previous incarnations. The pages that follow will help shed some light on themes related to your past life instincts. First, let's talk about reincarnation which is the belief that the current incarnation (as depicted by our birthchart) is linked to the lives that we have previously led. This collection of past influences points to particular experiences you might encounter again so that you can further your growth and fully develop your creative potential. These past impressions go far in shaping many of our current thoughts and choices. There are certain gifts a person seems to possess right out of the womb! It's as though destiny or fate leads one to realize these attributes. Of course, we still have to show ambition and make the effort in order to keep our dreams alive. This report may give confirmation to talents that you already know you have or open your eyes to ones that you have yet to discover.

Our past lives are alive and well in our consciousness. This may already be apparent to you. But on the other hand, these experiences can lie beyond the threshold of our conscious mind's awareness. What is doing the remembering, if our mind isn't? Call it your soul, higher consciousness or whatever explanation feels right to you.

Have you ever heard about karma, that great law of cause and effect? An old timeless saying sums up the whole process: "You reap what you sew." There are actions and thoughts that defined us in other lives, or have guided us to where we are in the present. They don't really exert any control over us. We have freedom of choice. That's a strong message to remember when reading this report.

Also, don't panic if you read something that says you were not a perfect person. Nobody is in the current one! Use the report as a learning tool. The idea is to keep developing and evolving. It's balancing the cosmic rhythm of past and present that presents each of us with a challenge. Do we respond positively or negatively? With hope or doubt? Many of our tendencies are linked to previous incarnations. Certain patterns have likely been by our side over many lifetimes. As we grow and expand our awareness, it becomes very possible to step beyond the trappings of past life baggage.

No doubt you will read various sections that seem to contradict each other. Each could be true about you. It's important to realize that many different dimensions of ourselves live within us. Each of us is composed of memories from so many past lives, combined with an assortment of ways we have learned to deal with reality in this life, that make us complex beings. See which descriptions ring true to you as you read through the following pages. You will notice some traits described have a repeating theme.

I hope you find this report an enjoyable ride into your past life instincts and thought patterns. They are somewhere in your consciousness. Perhaps some of what you read will strike a familiar chord. After all, these pages are all about your past life loves, creative pursuits,

adventures, travels, highs and lows, over many lifetimes. Happy navigating!

### **The Past Life Chart Structure**

Some technical explanations about the Past Life chart (if you detest technical discussions, then skip this paragraph and jump right into the report!). The Ascendant in this chart starts with the sign on the cusp of the 12th house, instead of the traditional method of using the sign on the 1st house cusp, which is the sign rising on the eastern horizon at the time of birth. Also, the Past Life birthchart houses are counted clockwise, rather than the conventional way of counterclockwise. In other words, since the 12th house becomes the Ascendant, the sign on the cusp of the 11th house now begins the 2nd house, etc., around the chart wheel. What is considered the Ascendant or 1st house in the traditional chart becomes the 12th in the Past Life chart. Your planets remain in the same sign placements, but now occupy different houses, in this new chart. The planets in signs are interpreted in your report from a past lives perspective.

Something interesting to consider in thinking of the houses in a clockwise direction, they are actually now moving in the same direction as the Nodes of the Moon. As you will read in the report the Moon's nodes are strong past life or karmic points in a chart. Their retrograde motion is clockwise meaning they share the same life biorhythms as the houses of the Past Life chart. By traveling backward, or clockwise, through the houses, you are being regressed back into a past life analysis. Enjoy your ride down memory filled lanes!

### **The Passport**

In this section are the first, middle and last names of your Past Lives astrological identity, the Sun, Moon, and Past Lives Ascendant. Each of these three building blocks will be discussed as to how they actively shaped many of your former lives. But before you meet these three key players, you will start your tour through memory lane with the North Node of the Moon. The North Node contains a special message about what was your overall life purpose. It was a constant rhythm pulsating in your consciousness to keep you on target toward your true purposes. It was a celestial compass trying to guide you to walk your talk with greater clarity. So sit back, and enjoy reading your past lives primer.

#### **Node in Taurus**

You had a history of attaining reliable resources. One of your key impulses was seeking comfort and ownership. Your soul was normally patient to reincarnate, knowing that a lifetime of work couldn't be done in a day. The archetypal theme for your destiny was to be a stabilizing force. A crucial lesson was not to get stuck. Becoming too attached to what you tasted, touched, smelled and owned kept you from expanding your growth. When you found ways to increase your wealth, it brought you great satisfaction.

There were times you were drawn into the danger lanes. A trickster was telling yourself that whatever came easy was not to be trusted. Life seemed an endless struggle. Finding a way to balance a sober outlook with seeking extreme intensity was a key to your fulfillment. Finding contentment with your desire nature regularly played a major role in your incarnations. You needed to know that you could trust someone with your deepest secrets and with your possessions. Claiming your own power in relationships and in other endeavors, shed great illumination. Betrayal by those you confided in threw you off course. Turning to your own values and resourcefulness pointed the way to wholeness. A tendency to explore life's mysteries deepened your understanding and taught you how to convert negatives into positives.

**Node in 6th house**

What types of activities did you participate in that furthered your soul growth? Pragmatic ideas paved the way for you to be attracted to learning new skills. You had an avid interest in diet and health. If you became too blindly devoted to causes lacking much reality it delayed your progress in finding your niche. A common concern was "how can I become more efficient in performing at what I like doing the best?" When you kept your expectations reasonable you managed to stay out of karma's way. What sorts of experiences motivated you? Getting an opportunity to put your know-how into practical use was a big one. When you found your true path, working extra hard to ensure success was an innate drive. Your energy levels peaked when you caught a glimpse of how to make your dreams come true. If you became ruled by divine discontent your ideals felt like they were merely lost in space. When you didn't try to be too perfect, this kept you on track as much as being too meticulous caused you to lose sight of the broader perspective. Somewhere, always hiding in the caverns of your memory banks were organizing instincts mixed with a tinge of powerful intuition. When using this wisely and faithfully, life was colored with a deep spiritual clarity, and you enjoyed putting great passion into a finely evolved imagination.

**Sun: Creativity, Ego, Self-expression****Sun in Leo:**

The sign of Leo the lion lighted the mid-summer astrological skies at your birth into this life. Let's explore what significance this had in regard to your past lives. In traditional astrology the keyword phrase for Leo is "I create". You had a repeating pattern about getting your message out there to others in a dramatic way. Promoting yourself, or those you loved, was a trait carried over from one lifetime to another. A dynamic will power paved the way for success. Your ego got bruised when you didn't feel you received your just rewards. A craving for attention made you somewhat vulnerable to the wishes of others.

Archetypes for Leo include the Queen, King, actor, and promoter. Power was an issue. Your lifetimes found you assuming too little or too much. When you were balanced in the wise use of authority your relationships and life in general were more harmonious.

**Sun in 4th house**

Your creative vitality became awakened when you saw ways to add to feelings of security. Home was godly in your opinion. You took pride in preserving the customs and beliefs that were heartfelt. Loyalty to family and ancestry was part of the package.

If there was a challenge, it was becoming too scared to show your true talent. A lack of confidence due to shyness or fear of failure was the source of this behavior. You did often outgrow being overly reserved. The hermit and silent one did live brightly through you. This isn't saying you were always a loner, only that you needed time to warm up to people. Your self-expression climbed the sky in a big way when you found the life directions that energized your inner dreams. Getting your moods in sync with your mind was a key to success. The world responded positively when you had the courage to initiate actions that were for the good of all, and not so graciously when you drew back into a reclusive shell. Getting beyond the negative memories of the past usually was a first step in the right direction. You found fulfillment in nurturing the growth of those you loved, and witnessing the birth of your most cherished plans.

**Moon: Sense of Security, Roots, Feelings****Moon in Aries:**

You were lunarized at birth through the sign of Aries. What does this say about your past life tendencies? An instinctual fighting spirit allowed you to survive calamities and dilemmas. The family ancestries in past lives were linked by a pioneering spirit. You searched your soul for the courage to act decisively.

**Moon in 7th house**

### **Mars: Assertion, Courage, Identity**

#### **Mars in Virgo**

## **The Journey**

**Saturn: Ambition, Seriousness, Focus, Responsibility****Saturn in Sagittarius**

Ambition came through you enthusiastically, says your past lives history, with Saturn placed in the adventurous sign of Sagittarius. Discipline was another matter. You didn't commit to anything that interfered with your freedom to roam the world in search of greater opportunities. Your greatest fear was being put into confining situations. Knowing where the exits were located was your first concern if you sniffed out a potentially frustrating path. There was a keen interest in education and religion.

A karmic shadow was self-doubt. Embracing a positive attitude made you more successful. You often defined yourself through communication and teaching-oriented professions, and as someone with great integrity.

**Saturn in 11th house**

Getting too lost in the left brain needed a little right brain, intuitive balance. You wanted from the deepest part of your soul to be able to accept your gifts as well as shortcomings. You found transcendental growth through letting go of self-doubt and choosing to give your time to those appreciating you.

#### **Neptune in 3rd house**

In what way were you extra intuitive? It was in regard to immediate ideas. You had a knack for tuning into a plan that might lead to opportunity. You didn't like stressful situations so did your best to keep them from getting started. You could think with great sensitivity and insight. Your idealism influenced your perceptions. You weren't one wanting to be talked out of your dreams and hopes.

It was a test to stay focused when you became distracted by worries or trying to move into too many directions at once. This doesn't mean you weren't capable of concentration. It is just saying that you really needed your attention to be poured into a project before it could be accomplished. Discipline came through the inspiration of your beliefs. Your spirituality was where you drew inner strength and was often the filter by which you examined reality. You were clearer when you stayed centered, whether through meditation or a quiet retreat. You had a sixth sense when it came to figuring out how to adapt to new situations. This helped immensely in responding to a crisis. What was the biggest challenge? It was in not denying what you really knew to be true. You indulged in this behavior to stay in circumstances not so wonderful for you. Faith transformed your denial into a more on target view of better choices. You searched for a purpose that had the sudden potential to sweep you off of your feet.

### **Pluto: Personal Power, Self-mastery, Rebirth, Loss, Passion**

#### **Pluto in Cancer**

Empowering yourself through securing your position in the world was a past lives tendency. When you decided to lay down roots, you found a feeling of permanency. Maintaining a sense of security was a regular pattern. You displayed charisma through an intensity to care about others. There was sometimes a mystery about the way you guarded your privacy. Sudden volatile mood swings were an occasional downfall. You were better received by others when this didn't become an often event. There were times when you swallowed your feelings rather than vent your true opinions.

There was a shadow. What was it? A haunting fear of change, or a loss of someone close. When you found the strength to deal with this side of yourself, you acted with greater spontaneity. Self-mastery was discovered through not projecting your own shortcomings onto others. You found rebirth or a sense of renewal when you greeted the present and future as the agents of a ticket to passionate growth, rather than as the disturbers of your comfort zones.

#### **Pluto in 4th house**

How did you go about seeking personal empowerment? By letting few people know your real secrets. You liked to keep your distance until getting to know someone. A renewed sense of purpose was discovered through purging yourself of the past when it had run out of its usefulness. It's not that you liked fast change, quite the contrary. But you suffered less when cutting your losses, or seeing that there was a brighter future waiting elsewhere. A location for a residence was important in that you derived great strength from power places. If the energy wasn't right you felt out of sorts. A powerful self-examination manifested if your moods got out of control. A compulsive tendency to dig up the seed of your dreams before they came to fruition got you to ask thought provoking questions. A shadow frequently followed you into incarnations associated with a fear of abandonment or loss. When you were able to face this thought pattern, a revitalized you was born.

## Footnotes

You have already been introduced to the ten planets. Certain planetary pairs in your chart have a special relationship to one another due to particular angular distances separating them, known as aspects. You could say the two planets in an aspect travel and interact together along the same circuit. The following aspects will be listed under five types. Two are known as the soft aspects: the sextile (60 degrees) and trine (120 degrees). These two aspects generally point to more gentle themes, and therefore will describe past life trends that went very well for you. They indicate a lower voltage of electricity and produced less friction in your mind and through your actions. The planets involved in a trine or sextile are more likely to talk about areas where you flowed without much effort.

The more hard or intense aspects are the conjunction (0 degrees), square (90 degrees) and opposition (180 degrees). They required your best understanding in past lives. Planets that are part of an intense aspect you will notice often indicate lessons that must be learned, and follow us from one incarnation into another until we get them in balance. These higher voltage aspects don't mean the planets operated negatively, only that there was much more force behind them. "Soft" does not mean good and "intense" does not imply bad. It is often the more intense aspects that deepen our soul growth, that is, if we learn how to use their power wisely. If we don't it's like taking one step forward and three back.

It might be helpful to keep some keywords in mind for the aspects. The sextile represents Excitation and Eagerness. The planets in this aspect give clues as to how their energies worked in a stimulating way through you. The trine is a special Harmony. The two planets involved show you were confident of their interacting energies. The conjunction is where two planets are joined at the hip. There is a Fusion or powerful blending of these energies. The square can reveal where you encountered Friction. Pay special attention to these aspects in particular because they denote themes that are strong past patterns. Squares ask us to resolve their conflict by finding creative outlets. The opposition requires a Balancing act. It is similar to a seesaw. Gaining objective awareness about each planet is a key. Remember, it was usually the most intense aspects that stretched you the most in past lives.

### **Moon square Mercury**

When you became emotionally upset, you became drained. This wasn't the most comfortable way in which to live. You became nervous if feeling too limited by where you lived. An intense desire to communicate always lined your brain synapses. A hungry appetite for learning new skills was a strong force. Verbal clashes required you to pick the battles worth fighting. You could draw close to someone and suddenly want space. Getting comfortable with intimacy was a challenge. .

### **Moon trine Saturn**

You accepted responsibility without feeling infringed upon. When you didn't want your life weighed down by someone else's problems, you might run away. People found you easy going and letting life come to you. Some saw you as too relaxed. When you did find an ambitious

streak, you were lucky in finding opportunities. You then only had to keep maintaining the effort.

**Moon trine Neptune**

Dreamy. Yes, you were someone that could sit and fantasize about the ideal lover and life. A fondness for what came without many hassles was your way. An attraction to the unattainable did one of two things. It either made you an idle dreamer or caused you to express your highest values. Reaching for the moon didn't always leave you empty handed.

**Moon square Pluto**

You had strong emotions that either helped you work through problems or got you overly attached to them. You lived like there was no tomorrow when you were moving fast along the directions you enjoyed. Living with you meant dealing with your mood swings. People had to figure out when it was best to leave you alone. Though it helped if you gave a clue. You enjoyed privacy. Betrayals in partnerships and in love left serious wounds. It was the aftermath, how you dealt with these events that was crucial to your ongoing happiness. Power struggles occurred. Being harder on a problem than a person was wise.

**Moon square Midheaven**

The pressure you put on yourself to satisfy work and home demands was stressful. Keeping these areas in balance was testy. If you became too overprotective it made you worry. Learning to let go gave your life more pleasure. You were intense about ambitions. A restless desire to achieve success was a trait. You had sudden mood swings that made for inner turbulence. This energy did at times bring instability. Although, when harnessed this force did give you the courage to try things otherwise that might have passed you by. It was important that you discriminated what causes were worth your time and dedication.

**Moon oppose Ascendant**

Relationships had a way of making you take a good look at yourself. You needed to be careful in not trying to find an unrealistic sense of security in a lover. Your intuition sensed who were the best individuals to have in romance or friendship, that is, if you listened to it.

**Sun conjunct Mercury**

You could think fast on your feet. Mental flashes quickly darted across your mind. Some thought you nervous, others brilliantly witty. Details either fascinated you or made you feel crazy. A sense of order was desired so you could clearly decipher how to manifest your creativity. There was a serious meticulous side, combined with a perception of life's absurd ironies. Communication was an area you always could declare bragging rights. If you talked without careful thinking, you did get into trouble. At least one critiquing eye constantly peered out its socket, analyzing fact from fiction. It was critical that you were harder on a problem than

on yourself or those you loved.

**Venus square Mars**

You attracted dramatic people into your lives. Why? Because you often were one yourself! Individuals either liked you or not. There wasn't lots of middle ground. When you liked someone, you didn't waste much time in making bold advances. Squabbles over money occurred regularly in relationships. You were not always fond of sharing, fearing you would get the short end of the stick. Instability in relationships was due to either impatience on one or both of your parts. Competitive streaks did get out of hand once in a while. Mutual support of values was a unifying factor.

**Venus oppose Saturn**

Love at times seemed like it was the one thing that got you through the struggles. Though lovers tested your inner strength to the maximum. In most lifetimes you thrived on long-term commitments. It was finding the right person that put you through great tension. You were afraid of being rejected, and this did make you a bit reserved. In non-romantic relating you had greater flexibility. Knowing how to negotiate was something you usually learned early. In matters of the heart, you realized that trying to control someone wasn't the answer. People trying to completely redefine you were likewise painful. Your highest days were spent with a lover sharing a give and take attitude. You let go better to a partner willing to work with you at building a stable existence. There was loyalty to those that were good to you. When others were willing to share their possessions it made you trust them. You had a patient way of not letting delayed gratification be a bother, as long as you knew a long-range plan was manifesting.

**Venus trine Ascendant**

Good fortune smiled upon you when it came to finding compatible relationships. Generally speaking, you met individuals that had similar values or at least could accept you the way you were. When you didn't give up on your dreams, they didn't give up on you.

**Mars square Jupiter**

Your actions tended to draw strong reactions. Waiting for just the right time wasn't your way. Too much confidence made you take chances that defied the odds. Sometimes you won anyway, and there were times you lost big. Gambling was in your blood. Playing it safe never entered your mind. Senseless arguing without any clear purpose wasted a lot of time and energy. You got your best mileage out of this one when you were moving toward a purpose. It was then that you had amazing energy to pour into your favorite interests. Exaggerating your potential was not so wise. People believed in you when living up to your promises. Restlessness was immense. You traveled and studied ferociously to stay preoccupied.

**Mars trine Node**

There was a relaxed momentum as far as pursuing your highest aspirations. This was sometimes mistaken by others as laziness, but was really an inner sense of knowing things would work out for the best. You were a source of inspiration for many. When you had a feisty nature life seemed to reach out and pull you into the right directions. When that spirit was down, you missed the cues. You were fortunate in numerous instances to dodge danger and find yourself on the trail of plenty.

**Mars trine Midheaven**

People thought you to be easygoing, but underneath that smooth exterior, was often a fast paced strategist. As a leader you won loyalty by being a straight shooter. Those in positions of power saw you as a unifying energy. You had an impatient streak that often sparked you to be assertive and even creatively adventurous.

**Uranus square Midheaven**

Creating stability wasn't your first impulse as there was a tendency to be an agent of change. Unfortunately this made it difficult to achieve stability at home or out in the world. Putting this inner and outer struggle to rest brought harmony. The challenge resided in being able to find ways to channel this forceful energy constructively. You anxiously wanted to receive support and approval for your goals. Breaking free from everyone else's expectations did point you in the right direction. Rebelling with no sense of purpose spelled disaster and left your life in pieces. Nobody could really say that you were someone without opinions. It was finding that middle ground of doing your own thing and not stepping on the rights of others that yielded fulfillment.

**Pluto oppose Midheaven**

You were sensitive about people getting behind your serious plans. Self-confidence came through steady successes. There was suspicion of authority figures. You just didn't like anyone having control over you. You were intense about commitments. Either you felt a deep bond or had trouble letting go. There wasn't much middle ground. If you accepted responsibility, you did this diligently. But there were times when dedicating your time felt like suffocation. It was best not to try to force you into decisions. Then again, you were grateful to someone for giving you a nudge when you were shying away from meeting a challenge.

**Pluto square Ascendant**

Conflict or friction in being yourself was felt due to the manipulation by others. Fighting to be empowered was a repeating scene. You had amazing instincts to survive very tough circumstances. When you relaxed into your identity, instead of forcing others to accept you, miraculous things happened. You were your own worst enemy when giving into self-hating behaviors. Blaming others for your problems was a defense mechanism. You got so attached to people or objects that it was hard to face losing them. Strength came through confronting your fears. Creative passion blossomed when you discovered outlets for a tremendous will power.

**Midheaven trine Node**

You believed in making effort but not forcing life to meet your demands. There was a quiet confidence that your ambition would be rewarded if you gave it your best. You were happier when staying true to a vast vision that incorporated experiences from all walks of the world.

Just as the Ascendant in the Passport section that began this report was described as a sign serving a special purpose, each of the other eleven houses has a sign that helps define its meaning. What follows is a trip through each of the other past lives houses or environments to give you a view of additional characteristics. First are listed the keywords for each house.

**2nd House: Comfort, values, money, ownership.****Virgo on 2nd house:**

You were somewhat of a worrier when it came to not believing enough in abundance. This kept you in limiting situations. Finding the faith to make changes gave you a new sense of vitality. A desire for a sense of order was something you valued, as was pragmatism. Allowing your intuition to find a voice gave you greater peace of mind. Staying focused on objectives without worrying about final outcomes made you more productive.

**3rd House: Perceptions, learning, communication, insight.****Leo on 3rd house:**

Nobody accused you of being shy. You spoke your mind, and rather bluntly. Your speech commanded attention. Putting ideas into action was your motto. You liked to hear yourself talk! Some people feared you if you became too bossy. Your colorful ideas could capture the interest of someone. Your attention span wasn't always long. An exception was when you were quite interested in the topic or perceived it was a means to getting your ends accomplished. You promised more than was humanly possible. A risk-taker you were. You only got into hot water when betting way over your head. A competitive mind with a feisty sense of confidence was often displayed.

**4th House: Home, security, nurturing, roots.****Cancer on 4th house:**

Home was a sanctuary. As a matter of fact, you probably were quite particular about where you lived. Family life was a central focus. This doesn't mean you were not concerned about other areas. **5th House: Self-expression, creativity, confidence, romance, risk-taking.****Gemini on 5th house:**

Your self-confidence made people want to believe in you. You excelled in broadcasting a message that influenced people to agree with you. An attraction to lovers with outgoing natures was a pattern. Investing in a long shot was not out of question, though it was wise to look before you leaped. Staying focused was a challenge if you went into too many directions.

**6th House: Learning skills, work environment, perfection, diet, health.****Taurus on 6th house:**

A hard-working and steady pace was dominant in your past. However, a tendency to seek self-indulgence caused problems. When you watched your health, life seemed more fun to experience. Much satisfaction was felt through putting your business sense to work. You gained momentum when people showed an interest or appreciation for your abilities. You were more fond of people exercising patience. Well laid out strategies guided much of your thinking. People grew frustrated with you when not showing enough spontaneity. You enjoyed life to a greater degree when not denying yourself some of life's luxuries.

**7th House: Relationships, marriage, partnerships, social awareness.****Aries on 7th house:**

A daredevil tendency in approaching relationships colored past incarnations. You had a pattern of attracting assertive individuals. People with a zest for life stimulated your energies. Your partnerships found you joining forces with people that had a similar competitive drive to get ahead. In lifetimes where you looked for too much of yourself in someone else, you got out of balance. People won your friendship when not threatened by your need to be assertive and direct. Impatience with others lost you a few friends. Though your adventurous spirit in making new ones kept you from getting too lonely. People challenged your need to be independent. It was learning how to differentiate between when to stay cool, and when to be a fighter, that brought you great wisdom. A restlessness to impress others with your abilities was a regular theme. When you were reasonable in your need for attention, there was less stress in your relationships.

**8th House: Power, joint resources, rebirth, passion, self-mastery.****Pisces on 8th house:**

Lovers and lifelong partners were not easy to understand individuals. They were driven by a desire to not be confined by the expectations of others. This isn't trying to say you never had fulfilling relationships. Only that romance had a way of testing your strength. It was painful to be betrayed by those you trusted. You could show great faith in a lover. Obsessive desires to be

with a particular person made you unhappy. When you established mutual acceptance with someone regarding beliefs and priorities, balance was easier to maintain. Your faith in a higher power helped you through just about any crisis. Money issues in relationships surfaced because of power conflicts. Denial caused you to misperceive reality.

**9th House: travel, learning, philosophy, knowledge, optimism.****Aquarius on 9th house:**

Let freedom ring was your anthem. You were anxious to learn what was going on in the minds of others. Sharing knowledge ignited your imagination. Impatience with normal routines did make for unpredictable times. If accused of being an eccentric, it didn't bother you. Why? Because you knew everybody else was wrong! When you kept your public and private lives balanced, you experienced greater joy.

**11th house: Goals, individuality, freedom, inventive, progressive, unique.****Sagittarius on 11th house:**

You had fiery enthusiasm about the future. This doesn't mean that you always had bright eyes when looking ahead or were never down. It's only saying that there was a spark lit when you found goals that inspired you. A lack of stimulation put your drive to sleep. Rebellious against routine was your norm. The present did move a little too slow for you. Innovative ideas made you come alive. Gaining knowledge liberated you from limiting circumstances. There were times when your blunt insights shocked a few individuals. Freedom meant everything to you. Sarcasm did anger others when you were insensitive. You were not as available for those needing you as they would have liked. This was due to moving so fast in new directions that others had to keep up with you. Your enthusiasm was contagious. An inner restlessness

propelled you forward. Channeling your energies constructively paved the way for a smoother ride.

**12th house: Idealism, intuition, escape, faith, beliefs.****Scorpio on 12th house:**

It was your beliefs that sustained you through the tough times. You experienced more rebirths in a lifetime than most would ever believe possible. Life was always ready to reveal its magic to you, that is, if you were willing to make the time to listen. Developing your intuition allowed you to see beneath the surface appearance of people and life circumstances. You didn't fear ridicule as much as your own inability to fight for what was right. You were a force to be reckoned with, when you acted like an immovable object. Romantic love had its highs and lows. It was wonderful when you and a lover were equally devoted. It was another story if you became addicted to the wrong type for you. It was just as true that certain individuals became obsessed with you in a way that made you want to escape their clutches. When you spoke with directness your communication was clear. Running away from issues was the shadow. When you acknowledged self-honesty, life was simpler. It gave you a clear sense of your mission. You usually sensed the fallacy in searching for the perfect love. But this didn't stop you from finding a soul mate!

Planets in actuality never really move backward, but can appear to do so. This is referred to as retrograde motion, and as you will read has special past life meaning surrounding a particular planet's symbolism. The following are planets that were moving retrograde at your birth with a description as to how this played out for you in other incarnations.

**Saturn retrograde:**

It was a repeating pattern that you had much to learn regarding flexibility versus rigidity. These two opposites were a sore spot of contention. A tendency to get extremely focused when you enjoyed a role was a past pattern. You were happier when feeling in control of your life. Knowing when to show vulnerability and when to show a tough set of armor was wisdom indeed! Some thought you lacked ambition. **Uranus Retrograde:**

It was a repeating pattern that you had unique goals, reserved just for you. When you didn't do this, life lacked meaning. When you solely served your own purposes this caused quite a ruffle in the feathers of those you loved and cared about. Finding the midstream worked the

best regarding these two extremes of sacrifice and doing your own thing. Your ideas sent shock waves at times when individuals or collective bodies didn't like the message. You did sometimes tap into a collective trend before it became in vogue. It did make you nervous about how you might be judged. Many ideas were kept internalized until you were sure the coast was clear and safe enough to present the notions. Were you ever more outwardly disruptive? For sure! This usually occurred when you were so aroused by injustices or thinking restrictions imposed upon you. There was a need to perceive with fore thought, which fights were worth the struggle. Being different just to be different or starting conflicts with no purpose, were ways you took many steps in the wrong direction. Listening to cues from the universe on which directions promised accelerated growth was wise. Your vision of the future was as strong as the ability to remember what gave your imagination an electrifying sensation. Patience took effort!
